

Exploration & Settlement of North America

 - To spread <u>religion</u>, escape persecution & better opportunity [Social]
 - **To find <u>riches</u> like gold & natural resources[Economic]**
 - To expand their <u>empire</u> & keep up with other European Countries [Political]



Jamestown 1607

Located along the Chesapeake bay in Virginia

(Southern Colonies)

Reason Founded: **Economic Reasons (Gold)**

Jamestown is considered to be <u>the 1st</u> <u>permanent English</u> settlement in North America

It was in the middle of a **<u>Native American</u>** territory.

The land was ***wampy**/warm & full of **mosquitos** that transmitted malaria.

Men came looking for gold & didn't come prepared with enough **food**

Eventually, **tobacco** saves Jamestown!








Plymouth - 1620

Located in Massachusetts (New England Colonies)

Reason founded: **Religious Freedom**

Families arrive and experience harsh **Winters**

Pilgrims arrived on a ship named the <u>Mayflower</u> & signed a document named the <u>Mayflower Compact</u>, it established <u>self-government</u>










New England: Important Information

The Middle Colonies were established for <u>political</u> reasons.




- The Middle Colonies had <u>immigrants</u> from all over the <u>Europe</u>.

- **Flat** Land








Southern Colonies: Economy
