Protects from the denial of life, liberty or property by government. Fair treatment at all stages of the law must be made.

Ex: Right to a fair trial







THE BILL OF RIGHTS

1st Amendment

- Freedom of Religion
- Freedom of Assembly
- Freedom of Press
- Freedom of Petition
- Freedom of Speech
- Freedom of Speech can be limited if a “clear & present danger” is created.



2nd Amendment

- Right to bear arms
- Right to carry your own weapon



Right to Bear Arms



3rd Amendment

- **Prohibits the quartering of troops in people's homes during peace time.**



4th Amendment

- Protects from unreasonable searches
- A Search warrant must be issued



5th Amendment

- **Due Process of Law**
- **Grand Jury Indictment**
- **Double Jeopardy: Cannot be tried twice for the same crime.**
- **No self-incrimination: You can refuse to testify against yourself.**
- **Eminent Domain: Property cannot be taken away unless it benefits society.**



Due Process



6th Amendment

- The Right to a speedy public trial in criminal cases
- Right to a lawyer or attorney
- Right to confront witnesses



7th Amendment

Right to trial in **civil cases** with jury. (**Money**)

Civil Cases such as **law suits**.



8th Amendment

No cruel or unusual punishment

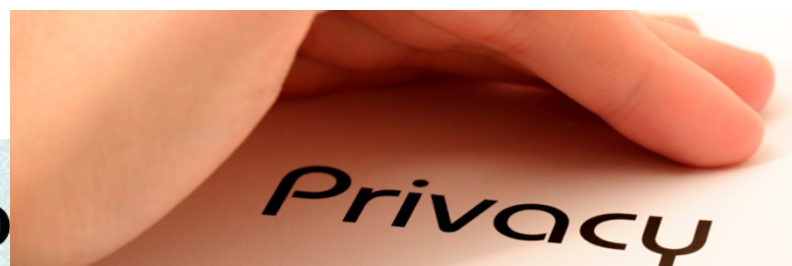
No unreasonably high fines or bail



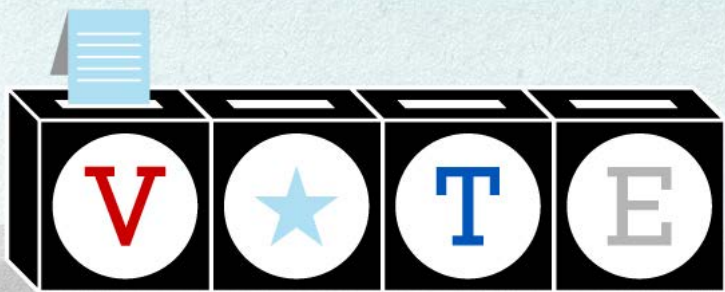
9th Amendment
